Things to look out for in your statement. At the beginning of every year Mountain Star FCU will send you the following documents for you to review:

Fee Schedule for 2024 Error Resolution Notice Privacy Notice 1099R by 01/31/2024 will be mailed out separately.

The monthly statement will include the 1099 INT information.

This year's IRA contribution <mark>deadline</mark> is Monday April 15, 2024.

Traditional IRA contributions are not limited by how much you make annually, meaning that anyone with an earned income is eligible to participate, but your contribution may not be fully deductible. There are Traditional IRA contribution limits to how much you can put in. The maximum total annual

contribution for all your IRAs (Traditional and Roth) combined is:

- \$7,000 (for 2023) if you're under age 50
- \$8,000 (for 2023) if you're age 50 and older
